

LONDON-PARIS BIKE RIDE

10 – 13 September 2010

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This event is being organised by Classic Tours on behalf of Severn Hospice. Classic Tours specialises in charity challenges of this nature and is fully covered by TOPP. Classic Tours is unable to accept liability for any loss or damage; however arising, or for cancellation of the event for any reasons outside their control.
2. For this challenge a registration payment of £100 (non-refundable) should be enclosed with your registration form.
3. By registering in this challenge you are pledging to raise the minimum sponsorship detailed below, though it is within the spirit of this endeavour to raise more for the Hospice if you can.
4. There are two funding options for this event. The first is to pay £625 to cover the costs of your participation in the event and to then commit to raising a further £625 in sponsorship for Severn Hospice. The second is to raise £1250 in sponsorship, of which £625 will cover the costs of your participation in the event and £625 will be given to Severn Hospice. You must notify us of your chosen method when registering for this event.
5. 10 weeks before the departure date (ie 2 July 2010) you are required to have sent to Severn Hospice 100% of the minimum sponsorship and costs according to the funding method chosen. At this time you will also be asked to confirm you have appropriate travel insurance.
6. If you cannot raise the minimum sponsorship your place will be forfeited unless you make up the balance yourself.
7. Should you have to withdraw from the event after making payment, you will not be entitled to a refund. Any additional monies you are holding at this time must be forwarded to Severn Hospice or returned to your sponsors.
8. If you withdraw in circumstances where recovery of cancellation charges is indemnified under your travel insurance, you hereby agree that you will co-operate in the recovery of these charges from the insurers and any sums recovered under the policy will be paid to the charity. If the insurance company does not recognise your claim, you will be responsible for covering any cancellation charges borne by the charity.
9. You must be at least 18 years old before the departure date of the event.
10. Itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of Classic Tours or Severn Hospice.
11. Of monies paid, £625 will be used to cover the costs of your transport, accommodation, food, transfers, guides and back-up team provided a minimum number of riders participate. All monies paid to Classic Tours for your travel arrangements are protected by TOPP.
12. You must not suffer from alcohol or drug dependency. You should not have any criminal convictions.
13. Your passport must be valid for the date of your return to the UK.
14. You participate at your own risk. If you are refused passage and/or entry/exit to or from France, any additional costs incurred are your responsibility.
15. You will be responsible for providing your own personal equipment. Your bicycle should be roadworthy and recently serviced at the time of departure. Please note it is a legal requirement in France that your bike be fitted with a bell.
16. It is a requirement that you must wear a cycle helmet at all times whilst cycling on this challenge.
17. You must have adequate travel insurance that will cover you for the specific activities you will be undertaking, including emergency repatriation. You will be asked to provide proof of travel insurance 10 weeks before the departure date (on payment of your sponsorship money) or you may forfeit your place on the challenge.
