

Quite often our Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) team is mistaken for Macmillan nurses and not recognised as part of the hospice team giving support in people's homes.

It's over 10 years since Macmillan funded the palliative care community nurses in Shropshire and the former Shropshire
Macmillan community nurses were adopted by Severn Hospice in 2011. To help us secure donations for this local charity to
support care for patients in Shropshire and North Powys we renamed the team as Severn Hospice Clinical Nurse Specialists.
