On your first day one of our Doctors and Nurses will come to see you and discuss your needs and how we can help you.

“I know my husband is being looked after too.”



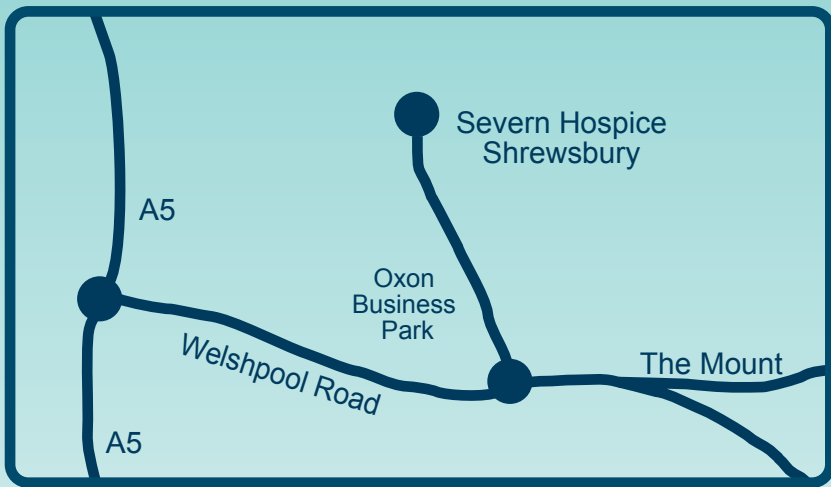


Additional information

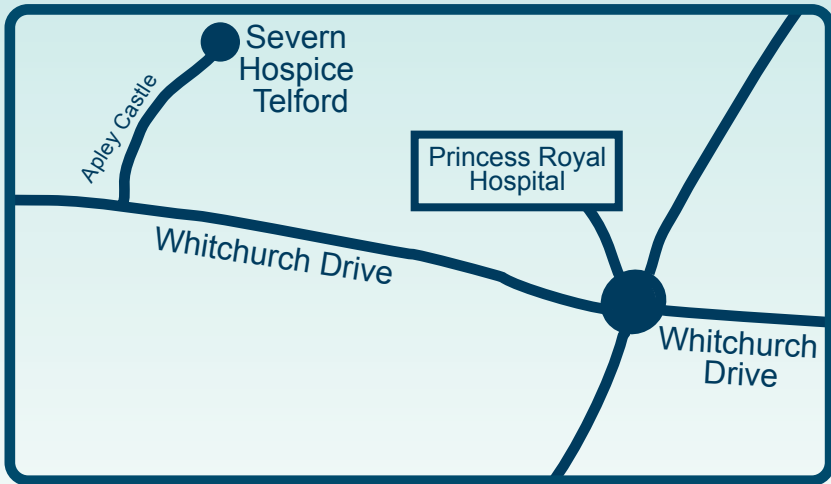
Care at the hospice is free of charge but not without cost.
