Our sanctuaries are available to everyone, whether you're staying with us, visiting for the day or visiting a friend or relative.

Our sanctuaries never close and you can visit whenever you wish.

## Religious support

The hospice welcomes all faiths and beliefs and if you would like your own minister, priest or religious representative to visit while you are staying with us then we will gladly arrange it.
