What to expect

Understandably, living with a progressive illness and facing end of life creates so many questions and uncertainties.

Our social workers provide practical as well as emotional and psychological support to people staying on our wards, those being cared for at home, or people who are visiting us for day services.

The team's support works alongside our medical, nursing and therapy colleagues.

It includes:

Emotional and psychological support

Facing and making decisions

Communication within the family

Coping with loss and change

Helping children understand loss

Planning for the future

Information and advice about things like care at home and benefits

Liaising with others on your behalf

Groupwork

Confidentiality

While you may be using different services across the hospice, you are within our overall care.

Our teams sometimes need to share information with other hospice colleagues to ensure your care continues to meet your overall needs.

Social workers will check when appropriate what they may or may not divulge to other hospice teams.

All this compassionate care and emotional support is provided totally free of charge, but it is not without cost.

Severn Hospice is a completely independent charity and has to raise £2 for every £3 it spends.

We are part of the healthcare network but we are not part of the NHS. All our services are funded through a combination of kind donations from local people, fundraising activities, our weekly lottery and community shops, gifts in people's wills and grants from the NHS.
