Match funding

Why not ask your workplace if they will match all or part of your fundraising?

Gift Aid it –

the little tick means more!

Your fundraising can be worth 25% more. If your supporters pay tax, all they have to do is tick the box on your sponsorship form, donation envelope or JustGiving page and we'll do the rest. It's that simple and it's at no extra cost to you or them!

It all adds up – for every £1 they donate, we'll get £1.25!

Say 'thank you'

Remember to say a big thank you to workmates, customers, clients and friends who have supported you. Sharing how much you have raised with their help makes everyone feel part of the fundraising family.

Need inspiration? Here are some of our favourites...

Sweepstakes

A great one to get everyone involved! You'll find everything you need to run a sweepstake in this pack. Ask colleagues, suppliers, customers, friends and family to guess your fastest time on the water – closest guess wins!

Get quizzical

Test your knowledge and donate to take part. Ideal for a bit of friendly team competition! Working remotely? Set up a Teams call so everyone can be in it to win it!

Office Olympics

Get into the sporting spirit with pencil javelin, rubber band archery and bin basketball and why not get some practice in with desk chair rowing!

Great office bake-off

Channel your inner Paul and Pru and take on your colleagues in an office bake-off. Pay to enter for your chance of being named star baker.



HAVE FUN STAY SAFE

If you are giving your sponsorship a boost with more fabulous fundraising activities, then there are a few things you may need to consider to keep it legal and safe.

Insurance

If you're planning an event that involves the public, you will need to think about insurance. Some venues already have this, so it's worth checking with them first.

Stay safe

It's important that your event is safe, and this means assessing potential risks and hazards for you, your helpers and anyone attending or taking part. Consider things like handling money safely, first aid, security, fire exits and possible accidents.

Food safety

If you're serving or selling food you may wish to check the Food Standards Agency guidelines on preparing, handling, cooking and storing food. You'll find them at food.gov.uk.



Licenses and permissions

You'll need to consider whether you need any licenses to keep your fundraiser legal. This could be a temporary event licence if you're serving alcohol in an unlicensed premises or hosting live music.

We'd love to see lots of photos from your fundraiser! Make sure everyone in the photo is happy you're going to share it with us.

Raffles

There are rules about running raffles, tombolas, sweepstakes and other lotteries.
